HOW YOU MAY UNITE WITH THE CHURCH

Regular Members are those who unite with this church through a) profession of faith, b) letter of transfer, c) reaffirmation of faith.

HOW YOU MAY UNITE BY PROFESSION OF FAITH

We welcome into our membership all who are willing to take the following vows in the presence of the congregation:

1. Do you acknowledge yourself to be a sinner in the sight of God, justly deserving his displeasure, and without hope save in his sovereign mercy?
2. Do you believe in the Lord Jesus Christ as the Son of God and Savior of sinners, and do you receive and depend upon him alone for salvation as he is offered in the Gospel?
3. Do you now resolve and promise, in humble reliance upon the grace of the Holy Spirit, that you will endeavor to live as becomes the followers of Christ?
4. Do you promise to serve Christ in his Church by supporting and participating in its worship and work to the best of your ability?
5. Do you submit yourself to the government and discipline of the Church, and promise to further its purity and peace?

Baptism administered by an ordained minister is required of all seeking membership unless the applicant has previously been baptized.

HOW YOU MAY UNITE BY LETTER OF TRANSFER

We will receive into our membership by a church letter anyone who is in good and regular standing in any Christian Church.

We do not require rebaptism, but accept as valid any Baptism administered by an ordained minister in the name of the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, regardless of the mode used.

The Secretary of the Board of our church will be happy to write for you a letter of transfer.

HOW YOU MAY UNITE BY REAFFIRMATION OF YOUR FAITH

Those who cannot secure a letter of transfer (some denominations do not grant letters to churches outside their own communion), or who have been inactive and wish to make a fresh beginning in the Christian life and rededicate themselves to God are received on their own statement of faith in Christ.

Associate Members are those who are active members of another Christian church who unite with this church without withdrawing from the church to which they already belong.

HOW YOU MAY UNITE BY BECOMING AN ASSOCIATE MEMBER

To become an associate member, you must be in good standing in the church to which you presently belong. Associate members share equally with regular members the duties and responsibilities and also the rights and privileges of membership.

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It is the responsibility of the Governing Board to examine and receive new members.

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STATEMENT OF COMMITMENT

Article II (from the Constitution of Amelia Plantation Chapel)

Section 1. We, the members of Amelia Plantation Chapel, recognizing that differences of belief which may exist among Christians are not inconsistent with unity, are committed to worship the living GOD; to study the teachings of Christ; to accept and witness to the loving and saving words and works of GOD in Christ, thus fulfilling GOD's intention for the wholeness of each person and the whole of mankind.

Section 2. We are committed to our church as a potentially powerful means of service in this immediate community and the worldwide community; to ecumenical cooperation among all helping persons and institutions, especially those of our Christian religion; and to cooperation among the members of our church.
